- Enjoy afternoon tea at volcanic crater lake, Lake Barrine, before an afternoon walk through the rainforest to see two massive Bull Kauri Pine Trees
- Spot wildlife such as the Boyd's Forest Dragon, Musky Rat Kangaroo and rainforest birds and learn about the plants and vegetation
- Visit a platypus viewing area in Yungaburra where we have a 90% success rate of seeing platypus.
- Enjoy dinner at a country restaurant in Yungaburra.
  Coffee, tea or hot chocolate provided (other drinks also available at your own expense).

- After dark and armed with a flashlight for our spotlighting, we then head back to the rainforest where the huge Curtain Fig Tree plays host to various species of nocturnal wildlife like possums and tree kangaroos.
- On clear nights, the minimal light pollution also allows star spotters to enjoy taking in the Southern Cross and Milky Way
- Return to your accommodation in Lake Barrine (9.00pm) or your accommodation in Cairns (10.00pm), Northern Beaches (10.45pm) and Port Douglas (11.30pm).
